



Camp Long Lake Campership

Every youth in Scouting has the opportunity to experience the excitement and challenge of summer camp. Inability to pay the full fee should not preclude participation. Those are the operational guidelines of the Council Camping Committee and the reasons that the Council supports a campership fund for summer camp.

It is the expectation that every youth should contribute some funds toward his camping experience. It should also be investigated as to whether the unit and the chartered partner may have ways of assisting the youth with camping fees. In those instances where there is a bona fide financial need, as determined by the unit leader, the Council will attempt to provide camperships to needy Scouts. Every campership application is to be completed by the unit leader. He/she provides the information for the campership. Applications should be submitted on behalf of the youth who are truly in financial need and whose attendance at camp would improve upon receipt of campership. A letter from the unit leader stating the situation will help in the committee's decision.

The deadline for receipt of campership applications is on the date of the final payment on May 3, 2020, but leaders are strongly encouraged to submit applications AS SOON AS POSSIBLE because:

- (1) Campership funds are limited (based on need & availability)
- (2) Reviewed and approved at May's committee meeting
- (3) The date that the campership application is received determines the total fee:
 - Which is the total fee for a youth that would be due as if the total payment was being made on that date.
- (4) Scouts/Leaders will be contacted 5-10 business days after May 3, 2020, if approved

Therefore, it is to the advantage of both the Scout and the campership fund to process applications as soon as possible.
