Come earn your engineering merit badge before the museum opens to the public! Scouts will be led through various activities to complete the 9 requirements, including meeting with a Harley-Davidson Motor Company Engineer, a staff guided tour through the museum learning about the progression of styling and engineering over the last 120 years of the company's history that also includes a trip to the restricted Motorcycle Vault, and several activities to learn about manufactured items and the movement of sound.

## Registration:

Registration can only be completed through Meg via email or by calling 414-287-2755. Due to the limited capacity and restricted areas that we will be in the number of adult chaperones per group booked will be between 2-5, depending on the troop size.

(For groups 5-10 scouts: 2 adults, 10-15: 3 adults, and 15-20: 4 adults.)

## Pre-Work:

There are 2 activities to complete prior to your arrival. These activities are things that cannot be done in a museum setting. They should not take more than 1hr to complete. Instructions for these activities will be sent out after registration has been received.
